Dear Professor Hunt:

The Landscape Architectural Accreditation Board (LAAB) at its March 18, 2024, meeting granted accreditation for a period of six (6) years to the course of study leading to the professional BLA degree at Ball State University. This status is subject to review of annual reports and maintenance of good standing.

Accreditation is awarded on a time-certain basis. The six-year period of accreditation ends December 31, 2029. Accordingly, the BLA program at Ball State University is next scheduled for a review during the fall of 2029.

In making its decision, LAAB considered the program's self-evaluation report, the visiting team's report, and the program's response to the report. After review of all of this information, LAAB removed the Recommendation relative to Standard 1 based on the program's response. Since this is no longer a Recommendation, the program is no longer required to submit an Interim Report for this removed issue.

There are no recommendations affecting accreditation.
