2014 COF SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED

In the spring of, the Council of Fellows Executive Committee reviewed applications from 20 candidates representing 16 programs before selecting Donna Freeman, a fourth-year undergraduate from the University of Arkansas; Rikerrious Geter, a third-year undergraduate from the University of Georgia; and Maria Munoz, a third-year undergraduate from Louisiana State University. This is the first year that we have increased the number of scholarships to three. The recipients will each receive \$4,000 as well as travel and registration to the annual meeting in Denver. CONTRIBUTE TO THE COUNCIL OF FELLOWS SCHOLARSHIP FUND

As of the last report in December 2013, the scholarship fund balance was \$271,377. In addition to over \$24,000 promised in pledges from 21 individuals since the last business meeting, Fellows contributed \$6,360 through the annual Fellows dues assessment. In 2014, ASLA will award three \$4,000 scholarships and pay \$1,000 per scholarship to LAF as a management fee. As you may know, during the annual business meeting in Boston last November, the Council voted to fund an additional student scholarship bringing the total number of scholarships to three. Each recipient receives \$4,000 plus travel and registration to the annual meeting. As the scholarship fundraising continues, we hope to have full participation from all ASLA Fellows, at any level. Beginning in 2013, we initiated the ASLA Fellows Endowment Fund. This planned giving campaign will help to fund scholarships and programs for future generations.
