### **SESSION DESCRIPTION:**

Section 1 & 2 are approximately 60 minutes each, Section 3 is 2.25 hours and Section 4 is 4 hours in length. Candidates may attend separate sessions or attend all 4 sections in full day. The session format enables candidates to assess strength and weakness, to preview problem styles, experience drilling, discover success factors as well as hear an over view of exam content to enhance overall exam performance. The Section 3 & 4 session features slides, videos, discussion, individual questions, 1 PPI book per session along with supplemental handouts plus customized post session follow-up emails.
